

## Changing your identification after marriage or Change of Name...

*This information applies to Manitoba residents.*

It is your responsibility to change your name on your personal identification and documents. In most cases, a marriage certificate or change of name certificate will be required. Below is a list of some offices you may have to notify if you are assuming a new name.
